MR. PORTER: Consider next case 1524.

MR. COOLEY: Case 1524. Application of Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company and British American Oil Producing Company for the establishment of rules and regulations for secondary recovery projects in the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Regarding Case 1524, Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company and British American Oil Producing Company, the applicants in that case have formally requested the withdrawal of this application and requested the same be dismissed. I, therefore, recommend that Case 1524 be dismissed.
