We are producing two wells from different horizons on a 40 acre tract, namely, the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 16, T.17S, R.31E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Our Macy #1 is producing from the Grayburg-Jackson Pool zone of the San Andres, and our Macy #2 is producing from the Seven Rivers. (Fren Pool.)

We have been producing these wells into separate tank batteries. The tank battery for the Macy #1 has got to the point when it can no longer be used due to corrosion and deterioration. This well only makes a few barrels/day. To prevent economic waste which would be occasioned by purchasing a new tank battery for this well we would like an exception to rule 303 so that we can comingle the oil on this tract.

We would like to have you schedule a hearing on this subject at your convenience and we will appreciate your consideration in the matter.
