It is proposed that TEXACO Inc. be allowed to continue to dispose of produced salt water in an unlined pit located in Unit O, Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This pit serves TEXACO's T. W. Heflin Federal Well No. 1, Cotton Draw Brushy Canyon Pool, which is also located in the above stated location.
