Reference is made to Administrative Order PC-406, recently entered by the Commission, and which authorized commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on your State Land "15" Lease in Lea County.

Inadvertently, the Tubb condensate production from this lease was omitted from the commingling authority. Administrative Order PC-406 is therefore hereby amended to permit commingling of the Tubb condensate with the Blinebry and Drinkard production after separately metering the Tubb condensate.

Administrative Order PC-406

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent letter requesting the amendment of Order No. R-1307 to delete the metering requirement in the commingling installation authorized by this order.

Inasmuch as this order was entered as the result of a public hearing, it cannot be amended except after a hearing. However, the commingling as you now propose is eligible for administrative approval.

Pursuant to Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Sun Oil Company, is hereby authorized to commingle Blinebry and Drinkard production on its State Land "15" Lease in Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of monthly well tests; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission in the event that any well in either pool becomes capable of top allowable production.

Order No. R-1307, which previously authorized commingling on this lease, is hereby put in abeyance.

Dear Mr. White:

On behalf of your client, Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company, we enclose two copies of Order R-1307 issued December 17, 1958, by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 1558, which was heard on December 10th at Santa Fe before an examiner.

Please note that this order requires that each meter installed in the subject system shall be tested for accuracy at intervals and in a manner satisfactory to the Commission. It will be necessary for Sunray to run a series of tests of sufficient duration to determine that the meters are functioning properly immediately following installation. Thereafter, tests should be made at intervals not to exceed one month and a report of said calibration filed with the Commission. The meters shall be calibrated against a master meter or against a test tank of measured volume.




