We enclose herewith BILL OF PARTICULARS which the Commission required in connection with the captioned case. A copy of the BILL OF PARTICULARS has been forwarded to the attorneys for El Paso Natural Gas Co. and Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corp., along with a copy of this letter of transmittal.

It was called to our attention, after the filing of this application, that the Commission has not yet undertaken to prorate gas in the Choza Mesa Pictured Cliff Pool and we therefore intend to offer evidence only as to the Blanco Mesa Verde Pool.

Robert Critchfield, one of the applicants, is now on an extended trip abroad and will not return until the end of May. We would like to have this case continued to the June or July regular statewide hearing of the Commission in order that Mr. Critchfield may be present. When the case is called at the April statewide hearing of the Commission, we would like to request that the records show that we requested a continuance of the case.
