Q In your official capacity as geologist for the Oil Conservation Commission, have you had an opportunity to make a study concerning the necessity or desirability of creating a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico?

A Yes sir, I have made a study of this pool, and due to the complications involved, I recommend that this case be dismissed in 1638, Case 1638.
