R-32-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

We are today forwarding to your office in Hobbs, New Mexico, completion forms in connection with the above described well, and asking for creation of a new pool designated as "El Mar (Delaware)". This well is a little over a mile northeast of our Discovery Well in the El Mar (Delaware) Field, located 330' from the South and East lines of Section 4, Block 54, T-1, T & P Survey, Loving County, Texas.

We feel that the State 36 Well #1 is an extension of the El Mar (Delaware) Field in Loving County, Texas, and would appreciate consideration being given to our request that the State 36 Well #1 be granted an allowable comparable to the wells in the El Mar (Delaware) Field of Loving County, Texas. There are three wells in this field, and each of them is allowed 100 barrels per day exempt from shutdown days.

We would appreciate very much your setting a date for the hearing of this application at the earliest convenience of the Oil Conservation Commission.
