As soon as possible, please set for hearing El Paso Natural Gas Company's Application for Non-Standard Location on our Huerfano No. 107 Well, located 1,460 feet from the north line, 1,180 feet from the west line, Section 35, 27-N, 10-W.

This well was originally projected as a gas well completion; however, it was completed as an oil well in the Gallup Formation. This well is closer than 330 feet to a quarter quarter section line.

Application for dual completion is being filed by our Farmington Office as of this date on this same well, since it appears that hearing will also be necessary for the approval of dual completion. It would be appreciated if this hearing could be set at the same time.

By letter of March 23, 1959, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application for a non-standard location for the captioned well. Accordingly, this application was set for hearing as Case No. 1643 on the Examiner Hearing docket of April 22, 1959.

Because of Case No. 1616, Order No. R-1357 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission dated March 20, 1959, it now appears that a non-standard location for this well has been approved inasmuch as it was drilled prior to March 20, 1959 on an unorthodox oil well location in accordance with the second paragraph of said Order.
