T R A N S C R I P T O F P R O C E E D I N G S

MR. PORTER: We will take up next the Nomenclature Case for the Northwest, Case 1690.

MR. PAYNE: Case 1690. Northwestern New Mexico Nomenclature Case calling for an order extending existing pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico.

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Mr. Buell, do you have something you want to say?

MR. BUELL: Yes, sir. Pan American is interested in Paragraph (g) of this case. That is the paragraph relating to the proposed extension of the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool. In the proposed extension area Pan American operates the Jicarilla Tribal "35" Well No. 1, which is located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 25 North, Range 5 West. Pan American feels that the facts surrounding the Jicarilla Tribal "35" Well No. 1 will justify the Commission in granting an exception to this well to its rules and orders requiring the saving of casinghead gas. As had been discussed here today, in the Otero Pool there is now a pool rule that prevents flaring. In order that we may have an opportunity to present these facts to the Commission, facts that we feel will justify an exception, I would like to move that the Commission continue the consideration of Paragraph (g) of this case until the regular July hearing. That will give us an opportunity to request a hearing, and have a hearing on this well prior to the Commission acting on this proposed extension.

MR. PORTER: Is there any objection to Mr. Buell's motion for a continuance of Paragraph (g) to the regular July hearing date? The Commission will continue Paragraph (g) of Case 1690 to the regular July hearing.

MR. BUELL: Thank you very much.

(Witness sworn)

A. R. KENDRICK,

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

Q Will the witness please state his name and position?

A A. R. Kendrick, engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Kendrick, in your official capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability for extending existing pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico?

A I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs be extended as shown in Paragraph (a) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of two wells capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (b) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that pool be extended as shown in Paragraph

(c) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Bisti-Lower Gallup be extended as shown in Exhibit 1, Paragraph (d), on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Chimney Rock-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend that pool be extended as shown in Exhibit 1, Paragraph (e), on the basis of three wells capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend that pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (f) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of four wells capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (h) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q Mr. Kendrick, have you prepared an Exhibit substantiating your recommendations?

A I have.

Q How is that designated?

A Commission's Exhibit No. 1, Case 1690.

MR. PAYNE: Mr. Commissioner, I move for the introduction of Exhibit 1 in 1690.

MR. PORTER: Without objection, it will be admitted. Anyone have a question of Mr. Kendrick? You may be excused.

(Witness excused)

MR. PORTER: If nothing further in this case, we will take it under advisement, and the hearing is recessed.
