AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. on July 15, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 21st day of July, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Mississippian formation, said pool to bear the designation "Bronco-Mississippian Pool." Said Bronco-Mississippian Pool was discovered by Amerada Petroleum Corporation, L. W. Ward No. 2 Oil Well, located in the SE/4 of Section 11, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed May 7, 1959. The top of perforations is at 10,939 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Caprock-Queen Pool and the Coyote-Queen Pool, both in Chaves County, New Mexico; and to the Dayton-Abo Pool and the Robinson Pool, both in Eddy County, New Mexico; and to the Justis-Drinkard Pool, the Ranger Lake-Pennsylvanian Pool, and the Shoe Bar-Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico; and to the Bluit-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico,

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Mississippian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Bronco-Mississippian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 11: SE/4

(b) That the Bluitt-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 20: S/2 and NE/4

(c) That the Caprock-Queen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM
Section 4: SW/4
Section 29: W/2 NE/4

(d) That the Coyote-Queen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM
Section 22: NW/4

(e) That the Dayton-Abo Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, NMPM
Section 27: S/2 SE/4

(f) That the Justis-Drinkard Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 26: NE/4

(g) That the Ranger Lake-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

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TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM

Section 23: SW/4

Section 26: NW/4

Section 27: E/2

(h) That the Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM

Section 1: S/2

Section 2: SE/4

(i) That the Shoe Bar-Pennsylvanian Pool, in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM

Section 26: SE/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be August 1, 1959.
