Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 24, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Monument Grayburg San Andres and Tubb production on your State "Q" Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that all production from both pools is of marginal nature.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.

Commission Order No. R-1460 which authorized the commingling of Monument Grayburg San Andres production and Tubb production on this lease after separately metering is hereby put in abeyance.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of December 2, 1963, wherein you request authority to remove one of the meters from your Monument-Tubb - Monument Grayburg-San Andres commingling installation on your State Q Lease in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This installation was authorized by Order No. R-1460 dated August 7, 1959, which order required that both zones be separately metered prior to commingling. Under the present commingling rules as outlined in the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," this installation is eligible for commingling as you have proposed.

Amerada Petroleum Corporation is therefore hereby authorized to remove the meter used to measure the Grayburg-San Andres production in the subject installation. Provided, however, that the installation shall in other respects continue to be operated in accordance with Order No. R-1460 and in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

       separately metering the production from each pool prior to commingling


  x   separately metering the production from Eunice Monument Grayburg-San Andres and determining the Monument Paddock production by the subtraction method

       well tests (if this method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of marginal nature; further, the operator shall notify the Santa Fe Office of the Commission in the event any well producing into the commingled battery becomes capable of top allowable production, at which time the Commission will amend this order or take such other action as may be appropriate)

Note: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Commission Rules and Regulations and the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: Prior to this amendment, Administrative Order PC-380, which put R-1460 in abeyance, authorized commingling of Eunice Monument and Monument Tubbs production on the basis of well tests.

Dear Sirs:

On August 7, 1959, Order Number R-1460 was issued granting Amerada Petroleum Corporation permission to commingle oil production from the Monument Tubb Pool and the Monument Grayburg San Andres Pool. This order requires that production from both pools be metered.

Under the present commingling rules as outlined in the Commingling Manual this lease would require only one meter.

Since one of these meters could be used at another location, we request permission to use the subtraction method as outlined in paragraph 2-B "Zones with Top Allowable Wells (all zones except one separately metered-Subtraction method)" in the Commingling Manual. All other requirements of the order would continue to be met.
