

DOCKET: EXAMINER HEARING NOVEMBER 10, 1959

Oil Conservation Commission - 9 a. m., Mabry Hall, State Capitol, Santa Fe, N. M.

The following cases will be heard before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner, or A. L. Porter, Jr., Secretary.

CASE 1803: Application of Boller & Nichols and Leonard Nichols for a water flood project. Applicants, in the above-styled cause, seek an order authorizing the institution of a water flood project in the Roberts Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, by the injection of water into the Grayburg formation through 11 wells located in Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, Township 17 South, Range 32 East. Applicants further seek the establishment of an administrative procedure whereby capacity allowables may be assigned to wells in said project without notice and hearing.

CASE 1804: Application of Cabot Carbon Company for an oil-oil dual completion and for permission to commingle the production from two separate pools. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order authorizing the dual completion of its Howard Fleet Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Pennsylvanian oil pool and the production of oil from the King-Devonian Pool through parallel strings of 1½-inch tubing. Applicant further seeks permission to commingle the Devonian and Pennsylvanian production from said Howard Fleet Well No. 1.

CASE 1805: Application of Chaco Oil Company for a water flood project. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order authorizing it to institute a peripheral water flood project in the Red Mountain Oil Pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, by the injection of water into the Menefee zone of the Mesaverde formation through 11 wells to be located on unorthodox locations in Township 20 North, Range 9 West. Applicant further seeks capacity allowables for producing wells in the project.

CASE 1806: Application of Franklin, Aston & Fair, Inc., for a water flood project. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order authorizing it to institute a water flood project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, by the injection of water into the Grayburg formation through 6 wells located in Sections 25 and 26, Township 17 South, Range 30 East. Applicant further seeks the establishment of an administrative procedure whereby capacity allowables may be assigned to wells in said project without notice and hearing.

CASE 1807: Application of Humble Oil & Refining Company for an exception to Rule 16 of Order No. R-586. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the reclassification of its State V-11 Well, located 2080 feet from the South and West lines of Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, as a Tubb gas well in exception to the gravity classification as set forth in Order No. R-586.
