Confirming our telegram of February 3, 1960, attached are three copies of our application for dual completion for New Mexico State M-20 accompanied by a map showing all wells on our lease and all offset wells on all offset leases as required by Rule 112-A. It is proposed to set 2-7/8-inch casing to the Langlie Mattix Pool completion and 4-1/2-inch casing to the Drinkard; this well is slightly more than one mile from the limits of the Drinkard Pool. The two strings of casing will be set and cemented side by side in a common well bore. It is our understanding that the program will be considered to constitute a slim hole dual completion in view of the use of one string of 2-7/8-inch casing. In this event, permission is also requested for such a completion under Rule 107.
