The following case will be heard before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner, or Oliver E. Payne, Attorney, as alternate Examiner:

CASE 2013: Application of La Plata Gathering System, Inc., for a gas-gas dual completion, for the establishment of a 345.59-acre non-standard gas unit, and for an unorthodox gas well location. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order authorizing the dual completion of a well to be drilled on an unorthodox location 990 feet from the North line and 713 feet from the East line of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Dakota producing interval. Applicant also seeks the establishment of a 345.59-acre non-standard gas unit in the Dakota Producing Interval, consisting of all of partial Sections 30 and 31, Township 32 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to the above-described well located on an unorthodox location.
