In addition to our May 16, 1960 application and reply to your June 7, 1960 letter, we are enclosing a revised diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion of the above well. The revised sketch shows the following items which were omitted from the original:

- Top of cement outside casing strings.
- Length of tubing string.
- Location of packer.
- Location of side door chokes.

Also, enclosed you will find data on surrounding wells completed in the Tubbs Zone. This data covers both gas and condensate production as well as gas-oil ratio tests.

We trust this additional information will enable you to process our application for dual completion of the Neville G. Penrose, Inc. #1 Grizzell and also for an 80 acre non-standard gas proration unit.






