Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby makes application for a hearing to consider an unorthodox well location for its Navajo Tribal "G" No. 6 which has been staked 310 feet from the south line and 2030 feet from the east line of Section 17, T-29-N, R-14-W, Cha Cha Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The standard location in Lot 10 of Section 17 falls in the San Juan River channel and the maximum orthodox alternate location is on the edge of the river at the bottom of the river bank. These conditions necessitated moving the drill site to an unorthodox location on higher ground adjacent to the river bottom land. The terrain conditions resulting in this request are illustrated on the attached copy of Form C-128, Well Location Plat, for the Navajo Tribal "G" No. 6.

Pan American also makes application for a hearing to consider a nonstandard proration unit for its Navajo Tribal "G" No. 6 consisting of Lots 9 and 10 plus the remaining acreage in the Navajo Tribal "G" Lease in the SE/4 of Section 17, being the S/2 of the San Juan River channel. Lot 9 of Section 17 contains 18.31 acres, Lot 10 contains 25.30 acres and the S/2 of the river channel contains 8.25 acres making a total of 51.86 acres in the nonstandard unit. The acreage to be dedicated to the Navajo Tribal "G" No. 6, as described above, is also shown on the attached copy of Form C-128, Well Location Plat.

It is respectfully requested that application for the nonstandard unit and the unorthodox location be set for hearing at the earliest possible date.


