Q What is your recommendation concerning the extension of the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That that pool be extended in accordance with paragraph (a) of Exhibit No. 1 on the basis of nine wells recently completed.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the extension of the Escrito-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That that pool be extended in accordance with paragraph (b) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of three wells recently completed.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the extension of the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That that pool be extended in accordance with paragraph (c) Exhibit 1, on the basis of four wells recently completed.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the extension of the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That that pool be extended in accordance with paragraph (d) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of three wells recently completed.
