Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of December 5, 1962 wherein you advise that it is the desire of Shell Oil Company to change the source of injection water for the Pilot Waterflood project in the Townsend Wolfcamp Pool from the Santa Rosa formation to the Ogallala formation further that you wish to increase the injection rate from approximately 1000 BWID to approximately 2000 BWID.

Subject to Shell Oil Company obtaining a water appropriation from the State Engineer Office for the Ogallala formation, the Oil Conservation Commission has no objection and hereby approves the use of said water in said quantities for the Pilot Waterflood project.
