The Oil Conservation Commission by Order R-2207, in Case 2512, approved the Gallegos-Gallup Sand Unit, San Juan County, New Mexico. This order is dated April 4, 1962. Paragraph 6 of the order requires that the unit operator notify the Commission in writing of the termination of the unit agreement and consequently the ipso facto termination of Order R-2207.
