Summary of proposed temporary rules for presentation at Examiner's Hearing, January 23, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico.

- 1. Temporary 80 acre spacing rules for one year with temporary 80 acre unit allowables appropriate to depth.
- 2. Staggered 80 acre pattern to be on a NW-SE diagonal with 80 acre units to be in N-S or E-W /2's of quarter section.
- 3. Wells to be located within 150 feet of center of governmental quarter-quarter section.
- 4. Exceptions, if necessary, to the above rules would be allowed for all wells commenced before the date fixed by the Commission.


