1. Temporary 80 acre spacing rules for one year with temporary 80 acre unit allowables appropriate to depth.
2. Staggered 80 acre pattern to be on a NW-SE diagonal with 80 acre units to be in N-S or E-W  $\frac{1}{2}$ 's of quarter section.
3. Wells to be located within 150 feet of center of governmental quarter-quarter section.
4. Exceptions, if necessary, to the above rules would be allowed for all wells commenced before the date fixed by the Commission.
