Our letter to you dated March 25, 1963, requested that our Valentine Well, located in Unit M, Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 31 East, be classified as within a buffer zone to the Newmont East Square Lake Waterflood, and be allowed to produce all the oil that the well will be able to make.
