Dear Mr. Porter:

In Order No. 2433, Case No. 2756, dated February 27, 1963, Humble Oil & Refining Company was authorized to complete its State "S" Well No. 24, (A Field Wildcat) located in Unit J of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (tubingless) to produce oil from Blinebry and Drinkard Oil Pools and an Undesignated Abo oil pool through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

Due to pays and shows encountered while drilling, this well was drilled to the Granite. We are planning to complete this well in the Granite Wash, Abo, and the Drinkard Horizons. Since we will not be able to get on the Docket for a Hearing to ammend the above order before June 5, 1963, it is requested that Humble's New Mexico State S-24 Granite Wash Horizon be authorized a temporary allowable upon a successful completion in order that testing and evaluation will not be delayed until the case can be placed on the Docket.
