RE: CASE NO. 2854: ATLANTIC SUPPORTS PAN AMERICAN'S APPLICATION IN CASE NO. 2854. WE WILL HAVE A WORKING INTEREST IN THE WELL PAN AMERICAN PROPOSES TO DRILL IN THE NE1/4NE1/4 OF SECTION 22. THE COMMISSION HAS ALREADY APPROVED AN UNORTHODOX LOCATION FOR GULF ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 22. THIS RESULTS IN THEIR OFFSETTING THE SOUTH MATIX UNIT WITH THREE WELLS AGAINST ONE. THE LOCATION REQUESTED IN THIS CASE WILL PROVIDE FOR PARTIAL COMPENSATING DRAINAGE. THE 80 ACRES PROPOSED FOR ASSIGNMENT TO WELL NO. 15 APPEARS PRODUCTIVE BECAUSE OF ITS STRUCTURAL POSITION AND THE FACT THAT IT HAS ALREADY HAD AN OIL COMPLETION LOCATED ON IT. ATLANTIC ALSO SUPPORTS DUAL COMPLETION IN THE SOUTH MATIX UNIT NO. 15 IN THE BLINEBRY AND ELLENBURGER. THE MECHANICS OF THE DUAL COMPLETION ARE BASED ON SOUND ENGINEERING PRINCIPLES AND A METHOD RECOGNIZED BY THE OIL INDUSTRY. DUAL COMPLETION OF THE BLINEBRY AND ELLENBURGER WILL PERMIT THE CONTINUED DEVELOPMENT OF THE BLTNEBRY WITHOUT THE EXPENSE OF DRILLING UNNECESSARY WELLS=

Continental Oil Company, as co-owner of the South Mattix Unit, supports Pan American Petroleum Corporation, unit operator, in its application for an unorthodox location and dual completion of the South Mattix Unit No. 15 to produce oil from the Fowler Blinebry and Fowler Ellenburger pools through parallel strings of tubing. Said well is to be located at an unorthodox location for the Fowler Ellenburger Pool at a point 660' from the north and east lines of Section 22, T24S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. Continental Oil Company also concurs in Pan American Petroleum Corporation's request for an 80-acre Ellenburger allowable for said South Mattix Unit No. 15 inasmuch as the Ellenburger was proven productive over the entire N/2 of the NE/4 of section 22 by the initial completion of the South Mattix Unit Well No. 3. This application is Case No. 2854 on the July 10, 1963 docket.

Continental Oil Company also supports Pan American Petroleum Corporation in Case No. 2855, being an application for a conventional dual completion of South Mattix Unit Well No. 1 located in Unit J of Section 15, T24S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, to produce oil from the Fowler Blinebry and Fowler Ellenburger pools through parallel strings of tubing.

It is respectfully requested that these two applications be approved by the Commission.


