A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Ted Collins and respectfully requests approval of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of the Zia Unit Agreement, for the development and operation of the hereinafter described unit area for the production of oil and gas or both from the Devonian formation, Lea County, New Mexico. The Zia Unit Agreement embraces the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, N.M.P.M.

Section 15 - S $\frac{1}{2}$
Section 16 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21 - E $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22 - All

containing 1,440 acres, more or less,
Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of said application, applicant would show:

1. That the Zia Unit Agreement is filed with the Commission as a separate exhibit, and made a part of this application.
2. That the lands embraced within the proposed Zia Unit area are owned by the State of New Mexico, subject to outstanding oil and gas mineral leases, and that the Zia Unit Agreement has been submitted to the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico for approval.
3. That the attached plat, marked as Exhibit 1, shows the Zia Unit area, and surrounding area.

4. That in the event this unit agreement is approved, applicant proposes to drill a well of sufficient depth to test the Devonian formation for the production of oil or gas or both, and upon completion of said well as a producing well, to continue development of the unit area on the basis of one well to each eighty acres, or upon such other spacing as may be authorized by the Commission, all as to be proposed in a plan of operations subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Public Lands.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before the Commission's duly qualified Examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Commission enter its order approving the Zia Unit Agreement, and for such and further order as may be deemed proper in the premises.
