A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now LEN MAYER and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for an order approving the location of a well no nearer than 990 feet from the North and East lines, nor nearer than 330 feet from any governmental quarter-quarter section line, of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, as an exception to the provisions of Order No. R-1670-E establishing special rules and regulations for the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, and in support thereof would show the Commission:

1. Applicant is the owner of the right to drill and develop the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and proposes to dedicate said E $\frac{1}{2}$ to the proposed well.

2. A well located as proposed by applicant will efficiently and economically drain and develop the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 32, will enable applicant to obtain his just and equitable share of the gas, and hydrocarbons underlying his land, and will not impair the correlative rights of other operators in the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Pool.

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3. Attached to this application is a plat showing applicant's acreage, proposed well location and the ownership of offsetting acreage and location of offsetting wells, to the best of applicant's information and belief.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before the Commission's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as provided by law, the Commission enter its order approving the well location as prayed for.
