Gentlemen:

Atlantic Richfield Company owns an interest in the Marathon Ralph Nix No. 1 Well located in Unit J, Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The Atoka Pennsylvanian Pool proration unit for this well offsets Mr. Len Mayer's proposed unorthodox location in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Atlantic Richfield Company offers no objection to Mr. Mayer's application as advertised. We urge, however, that the proration unit for the proposed well be restricted to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32. If Mr. Mayer feels strongly that a 320 acre proration unit, including the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, contains productive gas, then his application should be denied and he should be required to drill on a standard location.
