APPLICATION

Comes now MARATHON OIL COMPANY and applies to the OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF NEW MEXICO for approval of the dual completion (conventional) of the State Hansen Well No. 5, and in support of its Application states:

1. That MARATHON OIL COMPANY is the owner and operator of the State Hansen Well No. 5, located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, which well is presently being drilled.

2. That MARATHON OIL COMPANY proposes to complete this well as an oil-oil dual completion (conventional) in the Weir-Blinebry and Monument-Tubb Pools.

3. That it is proposed to produce the Blinebry formation through a string of 1.410-inch ID tubing, and it is proposed to produce the Tubb formation through a string of ~~2 7/8~~^{2 3/4} inch tubing, installed within a string of 5 1/2-inch casing set at total depth. Separation of zones would be effected by use of a Baker Model D permanent type packer.

4. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

WHEREFORE, MARATHON OIL COMPANY requests that this Application be set for hearing before one of the Commission's


