Dear Mr. Porter:

We would like a hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission in November 1962, for the following purposes:

(1) To establish a gas pool consisting of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) To establish a non-standard gas unit consisting of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

→ (3) To approve a non-standard gas well location of our well located 330 feet FNL and 410 feet FEL of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

This well is a re-entry of the plugged and abandoned well drilled by Skelly Oil Company and known as their No. 1-A Mexico "N". The well was tested upon re-completion by us as a gas well with an absolute potential of 1300 MCFPD.
