The Commission has heretofore approved our plan for secondary recovery operations on our Taylor Leases in Eddy County, New Mexico, described as follows:

S/2 Section 12; N/2 N/2 Section 13; S/2 NW/4
Section 13; SW/4 NE/4 Section 13; NW/4 SW/4
Section 13; all in Township 18 South, Range
31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.


We have formed what we called our Taylor Unit, unitizing the above lands into the unit as evidenced by the Taylor Unit Agreement, which has been executed by all of the working interest owners and the form of which has been approved by the U. S. Geological Survey in Roswell.

We are enclosing 3 Xerox copies of the executed Unit Agreement and request the Commission's approval of this unit so that we may obtain final approval from the U.S. Geological Survey.

The only lands covered by the Unit Area are Federal Lands covered by Federal Leases. There are no State or private fee lands in the Unit.
