OCC Hearing Set June 11th

SANTA FE, N.M. (UPD) — The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission has scheduled a hearing June 11 on proposed rules and regulations governing drilling for and production of geothermal resources in New Mexico.

The OCC was given authority to set up regulations for geothermal activity by the 1973 Legislature due to similarity of drilling operations for steam and oil and gas wells.

Dan Nutter, chief engineer for the OCC, said the staff had circulated its proposed rules and regulations "to all known interested parties." He also said the rules and regulations were discussed at a recent meeting of the Geothermal Resources Council in San Francisco, Calif.

The hearing will be conducted in Santa Fe at the Land Office Building.
