IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF CHAMPLIN PETROLEUM COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO INSTALL AND OPERATE A WATERFLOOD PROJECT IN THE CHAVEROO-SAN ANDRES POOL, ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

APPLICATION

Comes now Champlin Petroleum Company and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for authority to install and operate a waterflood project in the Chaveroo-San Andres Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, by conversion of its Farrell Federal No. 4 well to water injection and for approval of administrative procedures for expansion of said waterflood project, and in support thereof would show:

- 1. That application seeks permission to institute a waterflood project in the Chaveroo-San Andres Pool, by the injection of water into the San Andres formation.
- 2. Applicant proposes to convert to water injection its Farrell Federal No. 4 well located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 30, T7S, R33E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
 - 3. That the subject well is marginal.
- 4. That the proposed waterflood project will result in the recovery of otherwise unrecoverable oil, thereby preventing waste and will not impair the correlative rights of others.
- 5. Applicant further requests that administrative procedures be authorized whereby modification or expansion of the unit including the drilling of additional injection wells

and or producing wells, and the conversion of existing wells locations may be approved without further notice and hearing.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests this matter be set for hearing before the Commission's duly appointed examiner and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Commission enter its order approving the application as requested.
