A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW SOUTHLAND ROYALTY COMPANY by and through its attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the South Corbin Morrow Gas Pool for its South Corbin Federal #3 Well, located 554 feet FSL and 554 feet FEL (Unit P) Section 20, T18S, R33E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, with the dedication of a spacing and proration unit consisting of the E/2 of said Section, and in support thereof states:

(1) Applicant is the operator of its South Corbin Federal #3 Well located 554 feet FSL and FEL of Section 20, T18S, R33E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) The well was commenced on February 14, 1992, and on March 29, 1992 was temporarily abandoned as a dry hole in the South Corbin Wolfcamp Pool.

(3) Applicant proposes to re-enter the well and deepen it to the South Corbin Morrow Gas Pool with the E/2 of Section 20 being dedicated to the well.

(4) The unorthodox well location is sought to provide the most economical method to test the Morrow formation for production in this spacing unit and thereby:

1. protect against uncompensated drainage by offsetting existing wells;

2. reduce the risk and expense involved in drilling a new well from the surface at a standard location; and

3. affording the owners of this spacing unit the opportunity to share in possible production which otherwise may be drained by offsetting wells.

(5) In accordance with Division Rule 1207, the offset operators and affected owners who are entitled to notice, have been identified and set forth on Exhibit C, attached. Those parties have been set notice of this application by certified mail-return receipt advising each of their right to appear at the hearing requested by the applicant before the Division on August 6, 1992.

(6) Approval of the application, without a production penalty, will afford the operator and the other mineral interest owners for this spacing unit the opportunity to recover their proportionate share of the gas from the pool thereby preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, this Application be approved as requested.






