Reference is made to your request dated June 1, 1994, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Julie Com SWD Well No. 1, approved for injection by Division Order No. R-9750. Southwest Royalties, Inc. respectfully requests that the above referenced SWD order be amended to allow a top injection pressure of 952 psi. Even though our permitted injection interval was between 4000' and 5000', the cement bond log of 12/07/92 indicated a TOC of approximately 4550'. After consultation with the OCD personnel in Artesia, it was agreed we would perforate only below 4760'. Our actual perforated interval is from 4762' - 4954'. We feel the cement bond above and below this interval adequately isolates the proposed zone of injection.

If ever we wish to open the zones from 4000' - 4550', we will perform squeeze cementing operations to insure adequate cement coverage prior to commencing injection.
