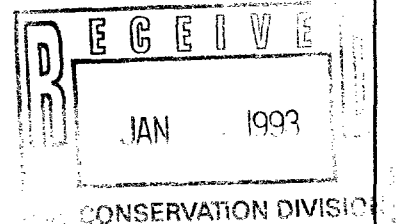

15 association or in conjunction with Case 10,610.

16 EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time we'll call
17 Case 10,610.

18 MR. STOVALL: Application of SG Interests I,
19 Ltd., for compulsory pooling and an unorthodox coal gas
20 well location, San Juan County, New Mexico.

21 MR. KELLAHIN: Same appearances, Mr.
22 Examiner.

23 These two cases were presented before
24 Examiner Stogner on November 19th, and the only
25 remaining matters to be presented were Mr. Roberts'

1 certificate of mailing, notification of the parties to
2 be pooled.

3 I have not yet received those from him. I
4 request that you take these two cases under advisement
5 and provide me an opportunity to submit that
6 certificate after the hearing.

7 EXAMINER CATANACH: Is that in both cases,
8 Mr. Kellahin?

9 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir.

10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, we'll go ahead and
11 do that.

12 I also -- For the record, I also have
13 received a letter from Tommy Roberts requesting that
14 that portion of Case 10,610 requesting an unorthodox
15 coal gas well location be dismissed.

16 MR. KELLAHIN: That's my understanding. It
17 has been processed administratively, and he prefers not
18 to have that item addressed in the Order for the case.

19 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. There being
20 nothing further, and pending the receipt of those
21 receipts, we'll take both these cases under advisement.
