

#### APPLICATION

Comes Now HALLWOOD PETROLEUM INC., by its attorneys, KELLAHIN and KELLAHIN, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox well location in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool for its Montoya #27-1 Well to be recompleted at an unorthodox location 790 feet FSL and 790 feet FEL (Unit P) Section 27, Township 32 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the S/2 of Section 27, T32N, R13W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico and proposes to consolidate the interests in this one-half section for the recompletion of the subject well.

- 2. Hallwood Petroleum Inc. originally drilled the Montoya #27-1 coal gas well to completion on March 13, 1979 with the well producing from both the Mesaverde and Dakota Formations.
- 3. In order to diminish the risk of drilling an uneconomic well, the Applicant proposes to recomplete its Montoya #27-1 well, located 790 feet FSL and 790 feet FEL (Unit P) of Section 27, for production from the Basin Fruitland Coal formation.
- 4. Because of geology, an unorthodox location in the SE/4 of the Section is better than a standard location in the NE/4 or SW/4 of said Section 27.
- 5. The well location in the SE/4 of Section 27 requires an exception to Rule 7 of the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool Rules (Order R-8768).
- 6. Pursuant to Division notice rules, a copy of this Application was mailed by certified mail-return receipt to each of the parties listed on Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing on May 6, 1993 before the Division's

Examiner and that after notice and hearing the application be granted.




