Comes Atlantic Richfield Company, acting by and through the under-
signed attorneys, and hereby makes application for approval of the
Robinson-Jackson Unit Agreement and in support thereof, respect-
fully shows:

1. That the Robinson-Jackson Unit Agreement covers 1,160
acres, more or less, of federal lands described as follows:

EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM
Section 27: SE/4, NE/4 and E/2 W/2
Section 34: NE/4, NE/4 SE/4, and NE/4 NW/4
Section 35: W/2 NW/4, NE/4, E/2 NW/4, N/2 SE/4
and NE/4 SW/4

The Unitized Formation consists of the Grayburg and a por-
tion of the San Andres formations as more particularly identified
in the said Unit Agreement, a copy of which is filed herewith.

2. At the time of filing this application, applicant has
received tentative approval of the proposed Unit Agreement by re-
presentatives of the Secretary of the Department of Interior and
the final draft has been submitted to the Oil and Gas Supervisor,
United States Geological Survey for final approval. Applicant,
Atlantic Richfield Company, is operator and sole working interest
owner of the Unit Area. The only other interested parties are
overriding royalty owners who are listed in Exhibit "B" to the
Unit Agreement.

3. That approval of the proposed Unit Agreement should
promote the prevention of waste and will promote the greatest ulti-
mate recovery of oil and gas from the Unit Area.

Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing be-
fore an examiner in Santa Fe, New Mexico at the earliest convenience.
