Blackwood and Nichols Co., Ltd. has requested administrative approval of the referenced unorthodox location for the Northeast Blanco Unit No. 433.

Meridian Oil Inc., on behalf of El Paso Natural Gas Company, Operator of offsetting acreage in the San Juan 30-6 Unit located in Section 30, T-30-N, R-7-W, objects to this unorthodox location. Our objection is based upon a need to protect the San Juan 30-6 Unit acreage from unnecessary drainage. The proposed well could be moved within the non-standard proration unit to the SW/4 Section 18, T-30-N, R-7-W and retain the same productive potential.



Dear Mr. LeMay;

Blackwood & Nichols Co., Ltd. requests administrative approval of an exception to the footage requirements of Rule 7, R -8768 for the subject well, located in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool.

This request is for exception due to topography. A Vicinity Map and C-102 are attached for your reference. This well was staked as close as possible to the existing well pad of the Northeast Blanco Unit No. 34 without interfering with the operating area for this well. The location is bounded on the west by the NIIP tunnel ROW which precludes any move in that direction. The location is bounded on the east by a very steep shale ridge with poor soil stability.

The west half of Section 19 and the southwest quarter of Section 18 will be dedicated to this well. All offset proration units are operated by Blackwood & Nichols Co., Ltd. except Section 30, T30N, R7W and E/2 of Section 25, T30N, R8W which are operated by Meridian Oil Inc. Meridian has been sent a copy of this request by Certified Mail.

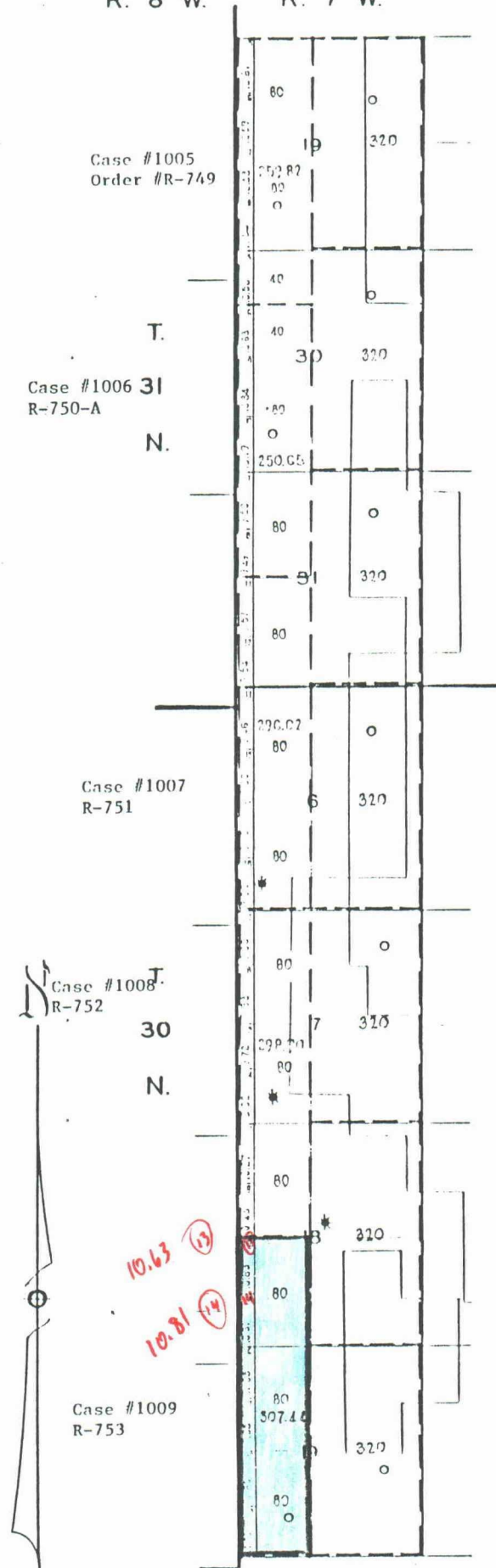

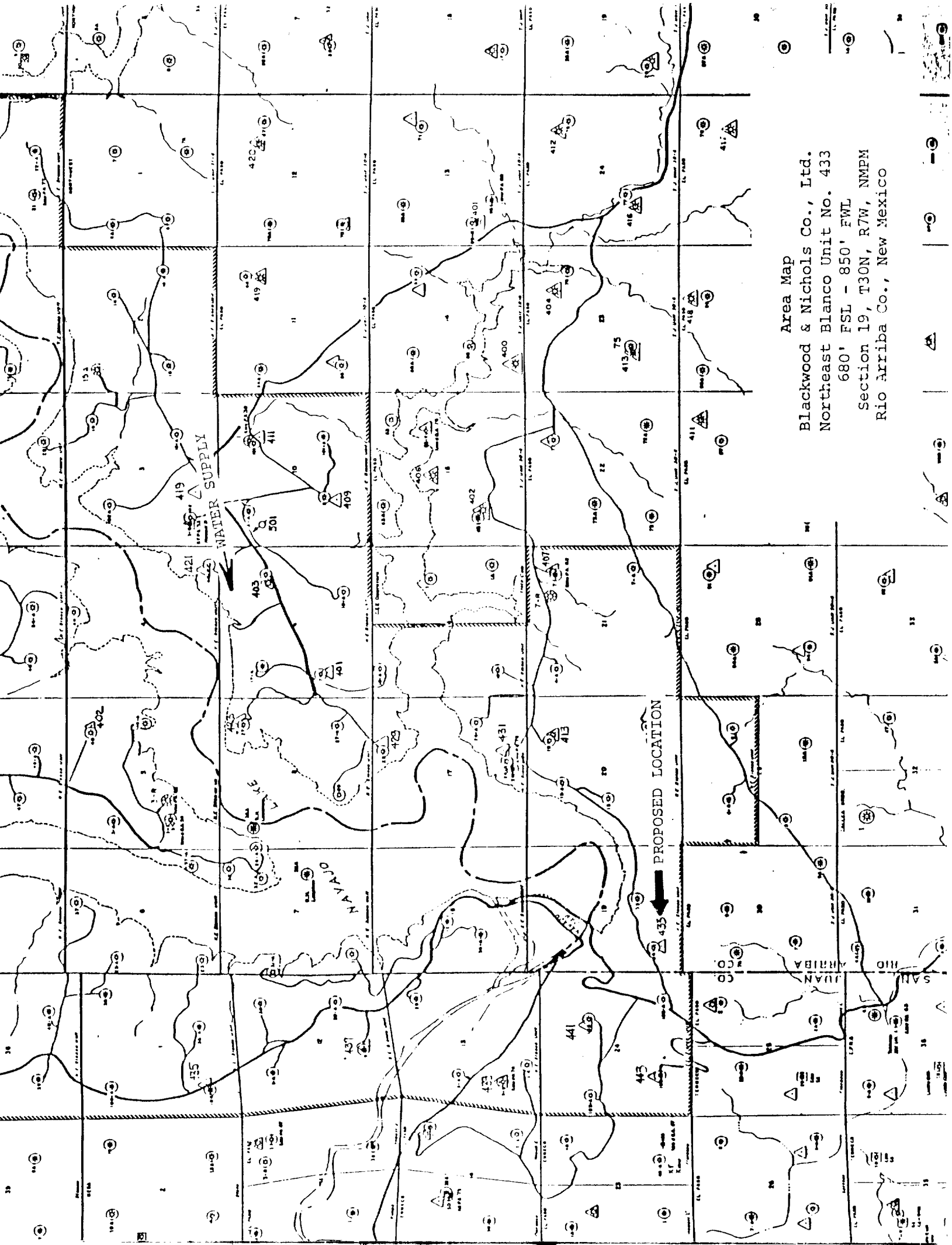
