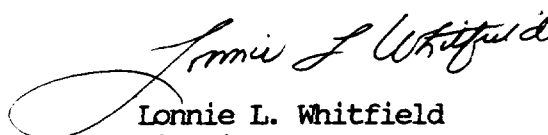
You will be receiving notice in the near future of a March 1, 1989 unorthodox location hearing to be conducted in Santa Fe, New Mexico for the above referenced well.
