This letter is to advise you that BP Exploration, Inc. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the force pooling of all mineral interests to the top of the Atoka formation for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing, in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. BP Exploration, Inc. also seeks approval to directionally drill a well on this pooled unit from a surface location of 1138 feet from the South line and 1633 feet from the West line to a bottom hole location within 100 feet of a standard bottom hole location at a point 660 feet from the South line and 1817 feet from the West line of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
