1. A hearing on the above matter is set for August 9, 1989.

2. Santa Fe Energy owns an interest in and is operator of the Longknife Federal Well Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 6 located in Section 36, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M.

3. Santa Fe Energy owns an interest in the Bereçade Federal Well Nos. 1, 2, and 3 and the Osage Well Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, located in Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M.

4. Siete Oil and Gas Corporation ("Siete") is the operator of the wells described in paragraph 3, and supports this application. *to Cont.*

5. Neither Santa Fe Energy nor Siete has had sufficient time to review and evaluate information regarding Meridian's application.

6. Representative of Santa Fe Energy and Meridian recently met regarding the application, but Meridian refused to show Santa Fe any data in support of its application.

WHEREFORE, Santa Fe Energy requests that the hearing on this matter be continued until August 23, 1989 to allow interested parties sufficient time to evaluate the application.

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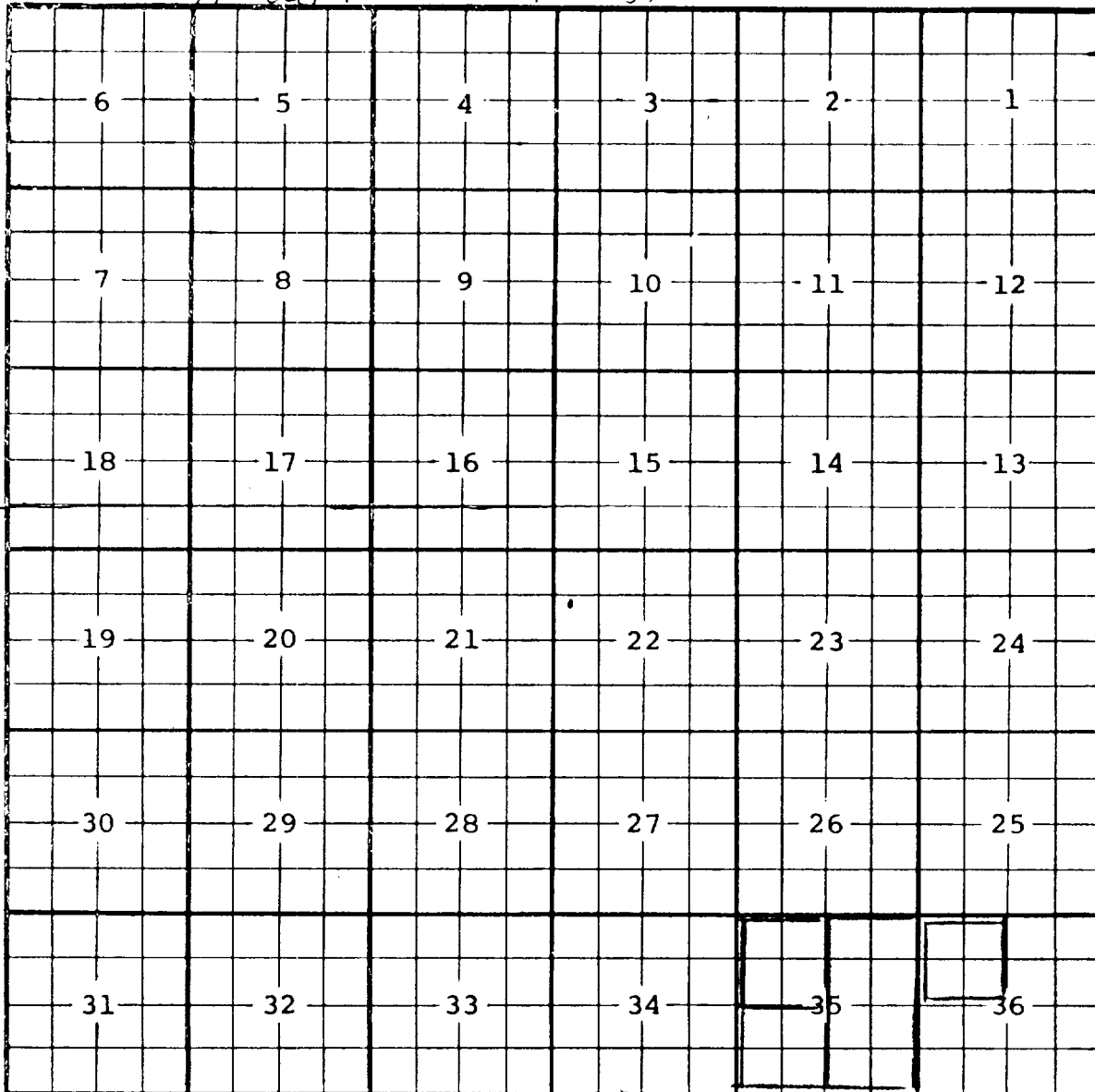
