APPLICATION OF QUINOCO PETROLEUM,
INC. FOR A NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION
UNIT, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

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ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 6, 1989, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 27th day of November, 1989, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) At the time of the hearing Division Case Nos. 9751, 9752 and 9753 were consolidated for the purpose of testimony, and inasmuch as all three cases concern acreage in Sections 2, 3 and 10, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, one order should be entered covering all three subject cases.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applications of Quinoco Petroleum, Inc. in Division Case Nos. 9751, 9752, 9753 are hereby approved for the formation of the following three non-standard gas spacing and proration units in the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool in Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico:

- a. 310.48 acres comprising Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8, the E/2 SW/4, and the SE/4 of Section 2 to be dedicated to its proposed State "N" Well No. 4, said unit to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 965 feet from the South line and 2165 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 2;
- b. 320 acres comprising the W/2 SW/4 of Section 2, the E/2 SE/4 of Section 3 and the NE/4 of Section 10, said unit to be dedicated to its proposed Federal "G" Well No. 4 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1620 feet from the North line and 1685 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 10; and,
- c. 320 acres comprising the W/2 SE/4 and the E/2 SW/4 of Section 3 and the NW/4 of Section 10, said unit to be dedicated to its proposed Yeager "N" Well No. 5 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1160 feet from the South line and 2315 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 3.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(2) The supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the Division shall evaluate the six existing South Los Pinos Fruitland Sand-Pictured Cliffs Pool wells located within the area encompassing the three non-standard units and operated by Quinoco Petroleum, Inc., as further described in Finding Paragraph No. (10) of this order.

(3) Should it be found that if any of the six aforementioned wells are producing gas from the coal interval of the Fruitland formation, than such production shall be deemed illegal and the operator shall cease production of illegal gas immediately.


(4) Such evaluation and any remedial work on the six aforementioned wells necessary to eliminate coal seam intervals shall be completed within 30 days from the date of this order.

(5) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
