- 2 Case 9791, application of Bannon Energy Incorporated
- 3 for extension and contraction of certain pools in Rio
- 4 Arriba County, New Mexico.
- 5 Are there appearances in this case?
- 6 MS. MATTHEWS: Yes. My name is Patricia
- 7 Matthews on behalf of Campbell & Black on behalf of
- 8 Bannon Energy Incorporated.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER: Any witnesses, Ms.
- 10 Matthews?
- 11 MS. MATTHEWS: No witnesses.
- Just briefly, Case No. 9791 was heard on
- 13 October 18, 1989. On that date there was some
- 14 confusion as to whether notice, according to the Oil
- 15 Commission rules, was provided.
- 16 The case was continued until today so that
- 17 Bannon could make certain that proper notice had been
- 18 given.
- 19 I've provided the examiner with an

- off the record.)

- 14 record.
- MS. MATTHEWS: At this time, I'd like to
- 16 offer Exhibit No. 1, which is a copy of the revised
- 17 plat of the affected pools that was requested by Mr.
- 18 Stooner at the earlier hearing as Exhibit No. 1. I'd
- 19 like to offer that into evidence, please.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibit No. 1 will be
- 21 admitted as evidence.
- MS. MATTHEWS: I'd also like to offer
- 23 Exhibit No. 7, which is an affidavit that proper
- 24 notice has been given in accordance with Rule 1207 of
- 25 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rules.

- 1 HEARING EXAMINER: Next case, No. 9791,
- 2 which is the application of Bannon Energy, Inc., for
- 3 extension and contraction of certain pools in Rio
- 4 Arriba County, New Mexico.
- 5 At this time I'll call for appearances.
- 6 MR. CARR: May it please the examiner, my
- 7 name is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm of
- 8 Campbell & Black, P.A. We represent Bannon Energy,
- 9 Inc., and I have one witness.
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER: Are there any other
- 11 appearances?
- 12 Will the witness please stand to be sworn?
- MARK E. WEIDLER,
- 14 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn
- 15 upon his oath, was examined and testified as follows:
- 16 DIRECT EXAMINATION
- 17 BY MR. CARR:
- 18 Q. Will you state your full name for the
- 19 record, please.
- 20 A. Mark E. Weidler.
- 21 Q. Mr. Weidler, where do you reside?
- 22 A. Farmington, New Mexico.
- Q. By whom are you employed, and in what
- 24 capacity?
- 25 A. I'm an independent petroleum geologist, but

- 1 I'm here representing both Bannon Energy, Inc., and
- 2 Jack Cole Production Company.
- 3 Q. Have you previously testified before the
- 4 Oil Conservation Division?
- 5 A. I have.
- 6 Q. When was that?
- 7 A. Approximately 12 years ago.
- 8 Q. Would you briefly summarize for Mr. Stogner
- 9 your educational background, and then review your work
- 10 experience.
- 11 A. Mr. Stogner, I have a bachelor's and a
- 12 master's degree from the University of Nebraska, both
- 13 in the field of geology. I have 35 years' working
- 14 experience as a professional geologist and 17 as an
- 15 independent.
- 16 Q. Have you studied the area which is the
- 17 subject of this case?
- 18 A. I have, sir.
- 19 Q. Are you familiar with the application filed
- 20 in this case on behalf of Bannon Energy, Inc.?
- 21 A. I am.
- MR. CARR: Are the witness's qualifications
- 23 acceptable?
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER: They are.
- Q. (BY MR. CARR) Mr. Weidler, would you

briefly state what Bannon seeks with this application?

- A. The purpose of this application is to

 extend, delete certain pool boundaries, the Counselors

 Gallup-Dakota Pool from a small area, Lybrook-Gallup

 Pool from a small area, and extend and consolidate the

 Escrito Associated Gallup Pool farther southeastward

 in an attempt to resolve some minor discrepancies.
 - Q. So what you're doing is contracting

 Lybrook-Gallup and Counselors-Gallup and extending the

 Escrito-Gallup?
 - A. That's correct.
- 12 Q. Have you prepared certain exhibits for 13 presentation in this case?
 - A. I have.

- Q. Would you refer to what has been marked for identification as Bannon Exhibit No. 1, identify this exhibit, and review it for Mr. Stogner?
- A. The exhibit shows the boundaries as of approximately August 1 for the Escrito, Lybrook, and Counselors Gallup-Dakota Pools, and shows generally that both the Lybrook and the Escrito Pool boundaries follow a northwest-southeast trending configuration, elongate in that direction and approximately a mile-and-a-half to two miles wide.
 - Q. The Escrito-Gallup Pool has been shaded in

- 1 yellow?
- 2 A. It has, sir.
- Q. It appears to me on this exhibit that you
- 4 have also shaded the east half of the southeast of
- 5 31. Is that intended to be shaded?
- A. Yes, it is because it was added to the pool
- 7 as an extension by the drilling of the Jack Cole
- 8 Rincon No. 11 Well in the month of July.
- 9 Q. Mr. Weidler, would you now refer to Bannon
- 10 Exhibit 2, and it might be helpful at this time to
- 11 also refer to Bannon Exhibit 3. Identify these two
- 12 exhibits and review what they're designed to show.
- 13 A. Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3 -- Exhibit 2
- 14 specifically shows a blowup of the area around the
- 15 common corners of Township 23, 24 North, and 6 and 7
- 16 West, where the Counselors Gallup-Dakota,
- 17 Escrito-Gallup Pool, and Lybrook-Gallup Pool become
- 18 contiguous.
- 19 Exhibit No. 2 specifically shows the
- 20 existing conditions in early August as to the
- 21 particular pool boundaries.
- Exhibit No. 3 is the proposed pool
- 23 boundaries as sought in this application.
- Q. And basically what we're looking at is
- 25 Sections 31, the northeast of 6, and the north half of

- 1 Section 5; is that correct?
- 2 A. That's correct.
- 3 Q. Have there been other recent extensions of
- 4 the Escrito Pool in this area?
- 5 A. The most recent extensions include, in
- 6 1988, the drilling of the McElvain Park Well in the
- 7 northeast quarter of Section 36 on state lands; the
- 8 drilling in 1989 of the Jack Cole Rincon No. 1 in the
- 9 northwest of the -- excuse me -- the northeast of the
- 10 northwest of Section 30 of Township 24 North, Range 6
- 11 West; and the southwest-northeast Section 30, Township
- 12 24 North, Range 6, in addition to the Rincon No. 11 I
- 13 previously referred to that is drilled in the
- 14 northeast-southeast Section 31, 24 North 6.
- 15 Q. Mr. Weidler, would you now refer to Bannon
- 16 Exhibit No. 4, and identify this exhibit for the
- 17 examiner and explain what it shows.
- 18 A. Exhibit 4 is a map which shows the proposed
- 19 pool boundaries, but superimposed thereon are wells
- 20 that are drilled on and in proximity to the
- 21 Escrito-Gallup Pool, and illustrate the net pay for
- 22 the main producing zone in the area, which we refer to
- 23 as the Mary 1 zone.
- 24 And you will see the contours define a
- 25 northwesterly southeasterly trending -- bar trend with

- 1 the contours I've illustrated extending from a net pay
- 2 thickness of 15 feet up to a maximum of 30 feet.
- 3 Q. This bar trend is basically an extension of
- 4 the trend that is underlying the pool as depicted on
- 5 Exhibit No. 1?
- 6 A. That's right, in the yellow on Exhibit No.
- 7 1.
- 8 Q. In the area that is involved in this
- 9 extension, who's the operator of all the wells that
- 10 will be affected in the extension area?
- 11 A. The extension area involves wells drilled
- 12 and operated by either Bannon Energy Incorporated or
- 13 Jack A. Cole.
- 14 Q. Are all the leases involved federal leases?
- 15 A. They are, sir.
- 16 Q. Will you identify for Mr. Stogner the most
- 17 recent development in this expansion area?
- 18 A. The most wells drilled were the Jack Cole
- 19 Rincon No. 7 in the northeast quarter of the northeast
- 20 quarter, Section 6, and the Jack Cole Rincon No. 5 in
- 21 the northeast quarter-northeast quarter, Section 5,
- 22 both Township 23 North, Range 6 West.
- Q. What is the spacing in the Escrito Pool?
- A. The Escrito Pool provides for 80-acre oil
- 25 spacing.

- 1 Q. And at this time the effective spacing in
- 2 this expansion area is in fact on 80-acre tracts?
- 3 A. It is, yes, by intent.
- 4 Q. How does the formation under this extension
- 5 of the Escrito that you're proposing compare to the
- 6 formation in the offsetting pools, both the Lybrook to
- 7 the south and the Counselors to the east?
- 8 A. As indicated on Exhibit 4, the contour map
- 9 showing net pay, you can see that the 20-foot contour
- 10 line fairly nicely defines the Escrito Pool. We are
- ll simply extending into the area that that contour
- 12 encloses.
- The sand is not mutually exclusive to this
- 14 area. It extends beyond but generally is thinner than
- 15 20 feet in its natural occurrence.
- 16 Q. So the thickest part of this trend is what
- 17 has been characteristically placed in the Escrito
- 18 Pool?
- 19 A. Yes.
- Q. Would you refer to Exhibit No. 5 and
- 21 explain that for the examiner, please.
- 22 A. Exhibit No. 5 is an illustration I prepared
- 23 from a formation density log within the existing pool
- 24 and illustrates the vertical layering of the zones in
- 25 the Gallup, and specifically identifies by yellow the

- 1 Mary 1 zone which I have contoured on Exhibit No. 4.
- Q. Where exactly is that well on Exhibit No.
- 3 4?
- 4 A. The well is located in the southwest
- 5 quarter-southwest quarter of Section 25 in 24 North 7
- 6 West.
- 7 Q. Let's go to the second page of Exhibit No.
- 8 5, and would you review what that shows?
- 9 A. That is the Marcos A-12 well which also has
- 10 the Mary 1 zone highlighted, and it was drilled in the
- 11 west half of the northeast quarter, Section 5 of
- 12 Township 23 North, Range 6 West, and is there to
- 13 illustrate the continuity and the similar expression
- 14 and thickness of the zone from one well log to the
- 15 other log, which includes the area we want to respace.
- 16 Q. Based on your study of this area, do you
- 17 have an opinion as a geologist as to what pool it
- 18 would be most appropriate to include the subject lands
- 19 in?
- 20 A. Based on the geological factors and also
- 21 the well performance and pressure information thus
- 22 far, it is our opinion that extension and
- 23 consolidation of this area within the Escrito-Gallup
- 24 Pool, Associated Gallup Pool, would be the logical way
- 25 to proceed.

- 1 Q. Mr. Weidler, would you identify what has
- 2 been marked as Bannon Exhibit No. 6.
- 3 A. It's a letter authored on Bannon Energy
- 4 Incorporated's stationery, signed by Mr. W.J. Hoakum
- 5 as agent for Bannon Energy, to Mr. Michael Stogner,
- 6 proposing the contractions and deletions that are part
- 7 of this hearing.
- 8 Q. Was a copy of this letter provided to all
- 9 offsetting interest owners?
- 10 A. It was, sir.
- 11 Q. Do you happen to know whether or not a copy
- 12 was sent by certified mail of a letter advising these
- 13 interest owners of today's hearing?
- 14 A. I cannot say for sure.
- MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, at this point in
- 16 time, we are unclear as to whether or not actual
- 17 notice was given by certified mail of today's
- 18 hearing.
- 19 For that reason, at the conclusion of our
- 20 direct case, we will request that the case be
- 21 continued to the November 15 hearing. During that
- 22 period of time, we will either submit to you return
- 23 receipts on the letters that were previously sent, or
- 24 we will provide notice so the 20 days will have run,
- 25 and anyone affected will have an opportunity to come

- 1 in at that time and express any objection, if they may
- 2 have such an objection.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr. Carr.
- Q. (BY MR. CARR) In your opinion, Mr.
- 5 Weidler, will approval of this application be in the
- 6 best interest of conservation, the prevention of
- 7 waste, and the protection of correlative rights?
- 8 A. Yes, I believe it will.
- 9 Q. Will Exhibits 1 through 6 either prepared
- 10 by you or compiled under your direction and
- 11 supervision?
- 12 A. They were.
- MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, at this time, we
- 14 would move the inclusion of Bannon Exhibits 1 through
- 15 6.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER: Mr. Carr, would you
- 17 approach the table?
- 18 (Thereupon, a discussion was held
- off the record.)
- Q. (BY MR. CARR) Mr. Weidler, I'd like to
- 21 direct your attention back to Exhibit No. 1.
- 22 A. Yes.
- Q. The boundaries that are set forth on this
- 24 exhibit, have you reviewed these boundaries, and can
- 25 you testify as to their accuracy?

- 1 A. They were compiled from information I
- 2 obtained from the OCD office in Aztec at that time,
- 3 and I believe they are correctly depicted.
- 4 Q. With the exception of the acreage in the
- 5 extreme southeast corner of Section 31?
- 6 A. At the time of preparation, that well had
- 7 not been drilled, the Jack Cole Rincon No. 11.
- 8 Q. Mr. Weidler, in addition to that, the area
- 9 that is the subject of this case is depicted on
- 10 Exhibits 2, 3, and 4; is that correct?
- 11 A. That's correct.
- 12 Q. Have you reviewed the information on these
- 13 exhibits?
- 14 A. I have.
- Q. Can you testify as to the accuracy of this
- 16 information?
- 17 A. Yes, I can. I believe they are accurate.
- 18 Q. If there's any inconsistency between
- 19 Exhibit 1 and the subsequent three exhibits, the
- 20 subsequent three would control; is that correct?
- 21 A. I agree, yes.
- MR. CARR: And I have no further questions
- 23 of this witness, I think.
- 24 CROSS-EXAMINATION
- 25 BY HEARING EXAMINER:

- 1 Q. Where did you get Exhibit 1?
- 2 A. I made it sitting in Ernie Bush's office up
- 3 in Aztec. He had the pool boundaries from their files
- 4 there, and I simply exerpted those and transferred
- 5 them to one map.
- 6 MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, if it would be
- 7 easier, I don't think that Exhibit 1 is controlling in
- 8 the case, and it was merely a general orientation
- 9 plan.
- I have no objection to not admitting that
- 11 and standing on the information in 2, 3, and 4.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER: There is some
- 13 discrepancies with what we have on our record and
- 14 Exhibits 2, 3 and 4. What I would like is to have you
- 15 resubmit Exhibit 1 --
- MR. CARR: We will.
- 17 THE WITNESS: Sure, be glad to.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER: -- from the records of
- 19 the nomenclature either in Aztec or here, if you
- 20 would, but I do not want to see this Exhibit 1, and I
- 21 will hand this back to you.
- MR. CARR: What we will do then is we will
- 23 withdraw Exhibit 1 and move admission of 2 through 6.
- 24 And with your permission, between now and the 15th, we
- 25 will submit a revised Exhibit 1.

1	HEARING EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr. Carr, and
2	I'll hand you back this Exhibit No. 1.
3	MR. CHAVEZ: At this time Exhibit
4	I'm sorry. Mr. Chavez?
5	(Thereupon, a discussion was held
6	off the record.)
7	HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibits 2 through 4; is
8	that correct?
9	MR. CARR: Through 6.
10	HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibits 2 through 6
11	will be admitted into evidence.
12	For notification purposes, this case will
13	be continued to the examiner's hearing scheduled for
14	November 15, 1989.
15	Will you be submitting additional evidence
16	at that time, Mr. Carr?
17	MR. CARR: We will submit nothing but a
18	revised Exhibit l and an affidavit with attached
19	evidence on notice.
20	HEARING EXAMINER: Are there any questions
21	of this witness at this time?
22	I have no questions. You may be excused.
23	This case will be continued to the
24	examiner's hearing scheduled for November 15, 1989.
