COMES NOW Southland Royalty Company, by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN, KELLAHIN & AUBREY, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of non-standard proration and spacing units in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool in Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, T32N, R8W, San Juan County, New Mexico for the following wells, which are to be or have been drilled at standard locations:

- * (1) Trail Canyon No. 100 - Section 7
- * (2) Trail Canyon No. 101 - Section 8
- ** (3) San Juan 32-8 Unit No. 201 - Section 9
- (4) Reese Mesa No. 102 - Section 10
- ** (5) Undesignated - Sections 10 and 11
- ** (6) Reese Mesa No. 103 - Sections 11 and 12
- (7) Reese Mesa No. 104 - Section 12.

* - The Trail Canyon No. 100 well location is 1790 feet FSL and 810 feet FEL of Section 7. The Trail Canyon No. 101 well location is 1850 feet FSL and 850 feet FEL of Section 8. These unorthodox locations have been previously approved by the Division.

** - Proposed wells - have not been drilled.

1. Applicant is a working interest owner and operator of all wells except the San Juan 32-8 Unit No. 201. Applicant is a working interest owner in that well.

2. As a result of governmental surveys, the northern side of T32N, R8W consists of a series of irregularly shaped lots, each of which contains more or less than 40 acres, resulting in the necessity for proration and spacing units, which are contrary to the Oil Conservation Division rules for Basin Fruitland Coal gas wells.

3. Applicant proposes to dedicate the following acreage to the subject wells:

- (1) Trail Canyon No. 100 - All of Section 7, consisting of 314.78 acres. (Exhibit B)
- (2) Trail Canyon No. 101 - All of Section 8, consisting of 375.07 acres. (Exhibit C)
- (3) San Juan 32-8 Unit No. 201 - All of Section 9, consisting of 382.84 acres. (Exhibit D)
- (4) Reese Mesa No. 102 - W/2 and W2/E2 of Section 10, consisting of 290.69 acres. (Exhibit E)
- (5) Undesignated - E/2 E/2 of Section 10 and W/2 of Section 11, consisting of 293.65 acres. (Exhibit F)
- (6) Reese Mesa No. 103 - E/2 of Section 11 and W2/W2 of Section 12, consisting of 299.89 acres. (Exhibit G)
- (7) Reese Mesa No. 104 - E2/W2 and E/2 of Section 12, consisting of 322.34 acres. (Exhibit H)

4. Attached as Exhibit A is a plat showing all of the acreage dedicated to the subject wells.

5. Attached as Exhibits B - H are plats showing the individual well locations and their acreage dedication.

6. Attached as Exhibit I is a list of all offsetting owners and/or operators who are required by Division rules to receive notification of this application.

7. Pursuant to Division rules, a copy of this application was mailed by certified mail, return-receipt requested, to all parties listed on Exhibit I.
