FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, seeks approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 20, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to its William H. Harrison "C" WN Well No. 3 located in Unit L of said Section 20.

(3) That the proposed non-standard proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the subject well.

(4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the gas in the pool, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 20, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby created and dedicated to the Sinclair Oil & Gas Company William H. Harrison "C" WN Well No. 3 located in Unit L of said Section 20.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
