STOVALL: 22 Mr. Lyon, would you please state your name 0. 23 and occupation. I'm Victor T. Lyon, Chief Engineer for the 24 Α.

Oil Conservation Division.

- Q. And you were previously qualified this morning. You understand you're still under oath?
 - A. Yes.

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- Q. Have you got a recommendation to make with respect to nomenclature in Rio Arriba, San Juan and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico?
- A. Yes, I do.
- Q. Is that recommendation prepared in the form of an exhibit?
- 10 | A. Yes, it is.
- 11 Q. How is that exhibit denominated, or how 12 will it be denominated when you so say?
- 13 A. Let's call it Exhibit A.
 - Q. Have you had the opportunity to examine Exhibit A and determine whether there are any differences between the recommendations in Exhibit A and the case as advertised?
- 18 A. No.
 - MR. STOVALL: Mr. Examiner, I'm going to offer Exhibit A into evidence in a moment, but I am going to request that the case be kept open until sometime tomorrow to allow the witness to make sure there are no differences in the nomenclature, the recommendations, and in the advertisement.

staff of the OCD as part of its official functions?

A. Yes, it was.

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- Q. And in you position as Chief Engineer of the OCD, are you responsible for overseeing in general those operations and activities?
- A. Yes, I am. And I visited with Florene
 Davidson just prior to the call of this case, and she
 had advised me that she and Roy Johnson had reviewed
 it, and that it was consistent, and there were no
 changes that needed to be made.
- Q. And that was in the course of their official duties?
- 13 A. Yes, it was.
- MR. STOVALL: At this time, Mr. Examiner, I

 offer Exhibit A into evidence.
 - HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibit A will be admitted as evidence.
 - MR. STOVALL: And would request that this case be left open for 24 hours to allow, make sure there are no variations between the advertisement and the exhibit.
 - HEARING EXAMINER: Mr. Stovall, I'm not quite sure that's necessary in this case. I think the documents have been reviewed by Division personnel, and I think we'll take that into account.
