Dear Mr. LeMay:

Reference is made to our letter to you dated February 27, 1990, attached hereto for reference, by which we transmitted for filing an Application by Doyle Hartman, Oil Operator ("Hartman") for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit, compulsory pooling and simultaneous dedication. That Application, subsequently assigned Case No. 9898, proposes the creation of a 280-acre non-standard Eumont gas proration unit consisting of the SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NW/4 and the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, both in Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

In the referenced transmittal letter, we notified you of the fact that Hartman had reached definitive written agreements to acquire the working interest of Oxy, USA Inc. ("Oxy") within the SE/4 of said Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 8, as well as the working interest of Oryx Energy Company ("Oryx") within the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 5. Those acquisitions by Hartman mooted Oxy's prior Application in Case No. 9884 for approval of a 200-acre non-standard Eumont gas proration unit for

portions of said Sections 5 and 8. Apprising you of that fact, we requested on behalf of Hartman that you dismiss Case No. 9884 in the event that Oxy failed to do so prior to the scheduled hearing on March 7, 1990. We further requested that you dismiss the Application of Hartman in Case No. 9885, which had sought approval of a 200-acre, or alternatively a 160-acre, non-standard Eumont gas proration unit for portions of said Sections 5 and 8, which was no longer desired or necessary since Hartman had obtained the working interests of Oxy and Oryx. Additionally, we withdrew the objection previously asserted by Hartman to the Application of Chevron USA, Inc. ("Chevron") in Case No. 9878 which seeks approval of a non-standard Eumont gas proration unit consisting of 160 acres within Section 8.

The course we urged in our February 27th transmittal letter regarding the dismissal of Case Nos. 9884 and 9885 and the withdrawal of Hartman's objection to Chevron's Application in Case No. 9878 were the culmination of Hartman's considerable efforts to accommodate all working interest owners of undedicated and non-producing Eumont tracts within said Sections 5 and 8. The requested actions also reflected a good faith effort on the part of Hartman to resolve the inherent conflicts among the applications filed by various parties without resort to unnecessary hearings and to avoid the attendant administrative costs for all parties. The withdrawal of Hartman's objection to Chevron's Application in Case No. 9878 and the requested dismissal of Case Nos. 9884 and 9885 were no doubt predicated upon Hartman's assumption that his acquisition of the interests of Oxy and Oryx were essentially complete. Having unconditionally agreed to the terms of their respective offers, including the advancement of a substantial amount of money as a downpayment. Hartman believes that his assumption regarding the finality of those acquisitions is well-founded. Believing that everything had been achieved which would permit the formation of the non-standard Eumont gas proration units proposed by Chevron and Hartman in Case Nos. 9878 and 9898 respectively, the dismissal of the superseded Applications in Case Nos. 9884 and 9885 and the withdrawal of Hartman's objection to Chevron's Application in Case No. 9878 were an eminently sensible and practical approach for preventing any potential conflict and alleviating the administrative confusion created by the previous applications.

On March 1, 1990, we received a copy of two letters sent to you under that same date from William F. Carr, also attached hereto for your reference, in which he advised he would dismiss Oxy's Application No. 9884 "as soon as the sale closes". Mr. Carr also stated his opinion that Case No. 9878 "should now qualify for administrative approval" because of Hartman's withdrawal of his objection to Chevron's proposed 160-acre non-standard Eumont gas proration unit. Since Mr. Carr's letters appear to question the closing of the transaction between Hartman and Oxy while seeking administrative approval of Chevron's Application No. 9878, they obviously create cause for alarm to Hartman, particularly in view of the fact that Mr. Carr represents both Oxy and Chevron. Although Hartman has no concrete reason to believe that the referenced letters from Mr. Carr actually reflect any intention by Oxy to breach the agreement between Hartman and Oxy in said Sections 5 and 8, we now believe it is advisable because of Mr. Carr's letters to take steps to protect against that unlikely contingency. Please be advised that Hartman hereby temporarily reasserts his objection to Chevron's Application in Case No. 9878, pending the final closing of his acquisition of the working interest of Oxy pursuant to the letter agreement dated February 20, 1990, and agreed to and accepted by Oxy on February 21, 1990. In addition, we respectfully request on behalf of Hartman that all of the Applications hereinabove referenced be continued to the hearing date of March 21, 1990. We feel confident that the transactions between Hartman and Oxy and Hartman and Oryx will be completed by that time, thereby allowing for the prompt approval of both Chevron's Application in Case No. 9878 and Hartman's Application in Case No. 9898 and the dismissal of the Applications in Case No. 9884 and 9885.

Enclosed for filing please find the original and two copies of the referenced Application and an additional copy which we request you stamp as received and return to us for our file. Pursuant to Rule 1207(a) 1 and 3 of the Rules on Procedure, we have notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, those parties listed on Exhibit "B" to the Application as stated therein. We will provide the certificates or return receipts evidencing such notification, or attempted notification, at the hearing on the Application. We respectfully request you publish notice of the enclosed Application according to Rules 1204 and 1205 and place the enclosed Application on the docket for hearing before an Examiner on March 21, 1990.

Please be advised that, pursuant to the letter agreements referenced on Exhibit "B" of the enclosed Application, Doyle Hartman has reached definitive written agreements to acquire the working interest of Oxy USA, Inc. ("Oxy") within the SE/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, as well as the working interest of Oryx Energy Company ("Oryx") in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, all in Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County New Mexico. Oxy had previously applied to the Division in Case No. 9884 for a non-standard Eumont gas proration unit consisting of 200 acres, being the SE/4 of said Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 8. Because Hartman has now acquired the working interests previously held by Oxy and Oryx in those tracts and has included such acreage within the 280-acre non-standard Eumont gas proration proposed in the enclosed Application, we expect Oxy to withdraw its Application No. 9884. In the event Oxy fails to do so, we respectfully request the Division to dismiss Application No. 9884 prior to its scheduled hearing on March 7, 1990.



By application dated January 3, 1990, Chevron U.S.A., Inc. sought administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont (Yates, Seven Rivers, Queen) Gas Pool, comprised of the W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Chevron also sought administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate its Bertie Whitmire Wells Nos. 1 and 2 located in Units G and B, respectively, of said Section 8.

Reference is made to my telephone conversation of this date with Mr. David Messer, wherein we discussed Chevron's pending application to form a 160-acre non-standard Eumont Gas Pool proration unit consisting of the W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4 and SE/4 NW/4 Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, and to simultaneously dedicate Chevron's No. 1 and No. 2 Bertie Whitmire wells to its proposed 160-acre non-standard Eumont proration unit.

Pursuant to the agreement reached on February 21, 1990 between Doyle Hartman and OXY USA, Inc. we now own (pending completion of the necessary instruments) the Eumont Gas Pool rights formerly owned by OXY in and under the NE/4 NE/4 Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E.

Since October, 1989, we have been attempting to acquire the Eumont Gas Pool rights owned by Amerada Hess in and under the E/2 SW/4 Section 8, although these negotiations are progressing at a rather slow pace. In fact, it may be necessary to have Amerada Hess participate with us in the redevelopment of the Eumont interval in and under their lease, if we are unable to negotiate an equitable trade. And, as you are aware, we are also in the process of acquiring from OXY, Oryx Energy and Phillips Petroleum Company the Eumont Gas Pool rights in and under the SE/4 SW/4 and SE/4 Section 5, T-20-S, R-37-E.

Per our conversation of this date, we propose to withdraw our objection to Chevron's referenced application provided that Chevron is agreeable to reforming (at a later date) its 160-acre non-standard Eumont proration unit corresponding to its Bertie Whitmire lease at such time as we have acquired sufficient additional acreage to include in an enlarged Eumont proration unit for our Britt B-8 well in the NE/4 NW/4 Section 8. This would require that Chevron trade its Eumont Gas Pool Chevron USA Inc. February 22, 1990 Page 2

rights, as we have previously proposed, in the SE/4 NW/4 Section 8 (at an 87.50% net revenue interest) in exchange for our Eumont Gas Pool rights in the NE/4 NE/4 Section 8 (at an 87.50 net revenue interest) and to reform your 160-acre Eumont proration unit to include all of the NE/4 Section 8, but exclude the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 8 from the reformed Eumont proration unit. We, of course, will immediately file an amended proration unit application with the NMOCD which deletes Chevron's acreage therefrom, subject to the terms of our agreement with Chevron. It would further provide us with sufficient time to pursue an equitable trade with Amerada as to their lease in the E/2 SW/4 Section 8. 


