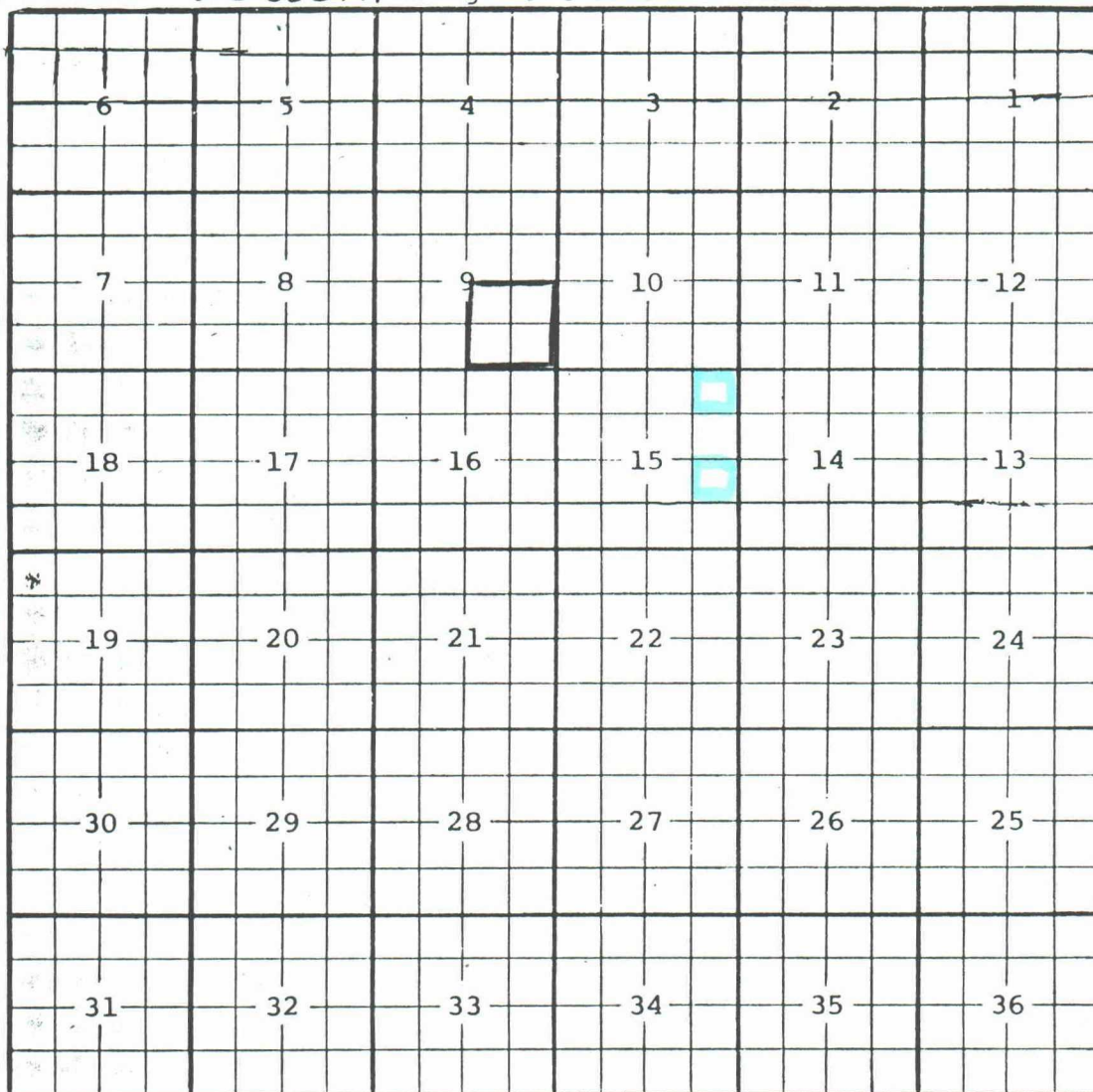

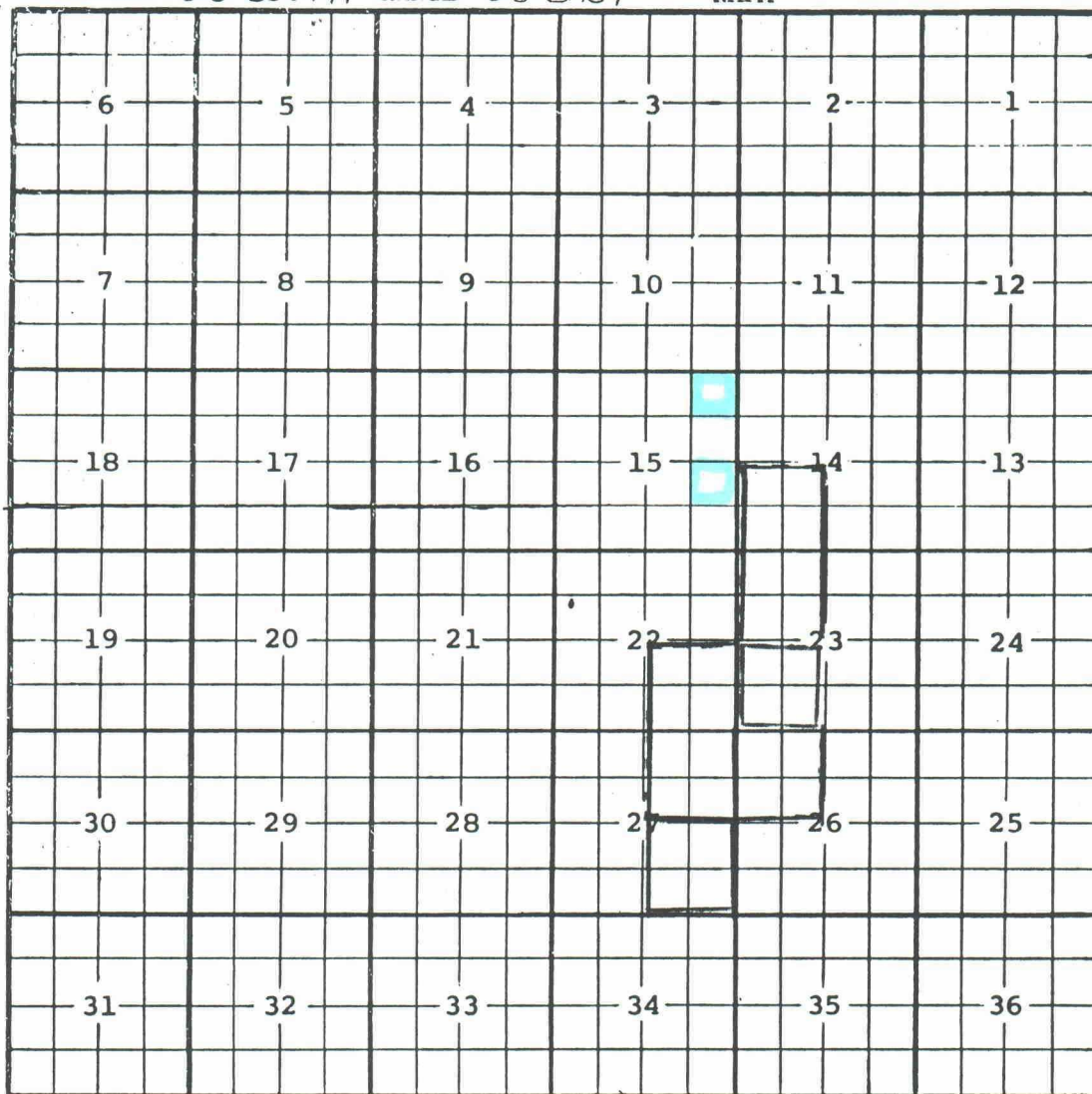
TOWNSHIP 23 South Range 28 East NMPM

TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH RANGE 28 EAST NMPM



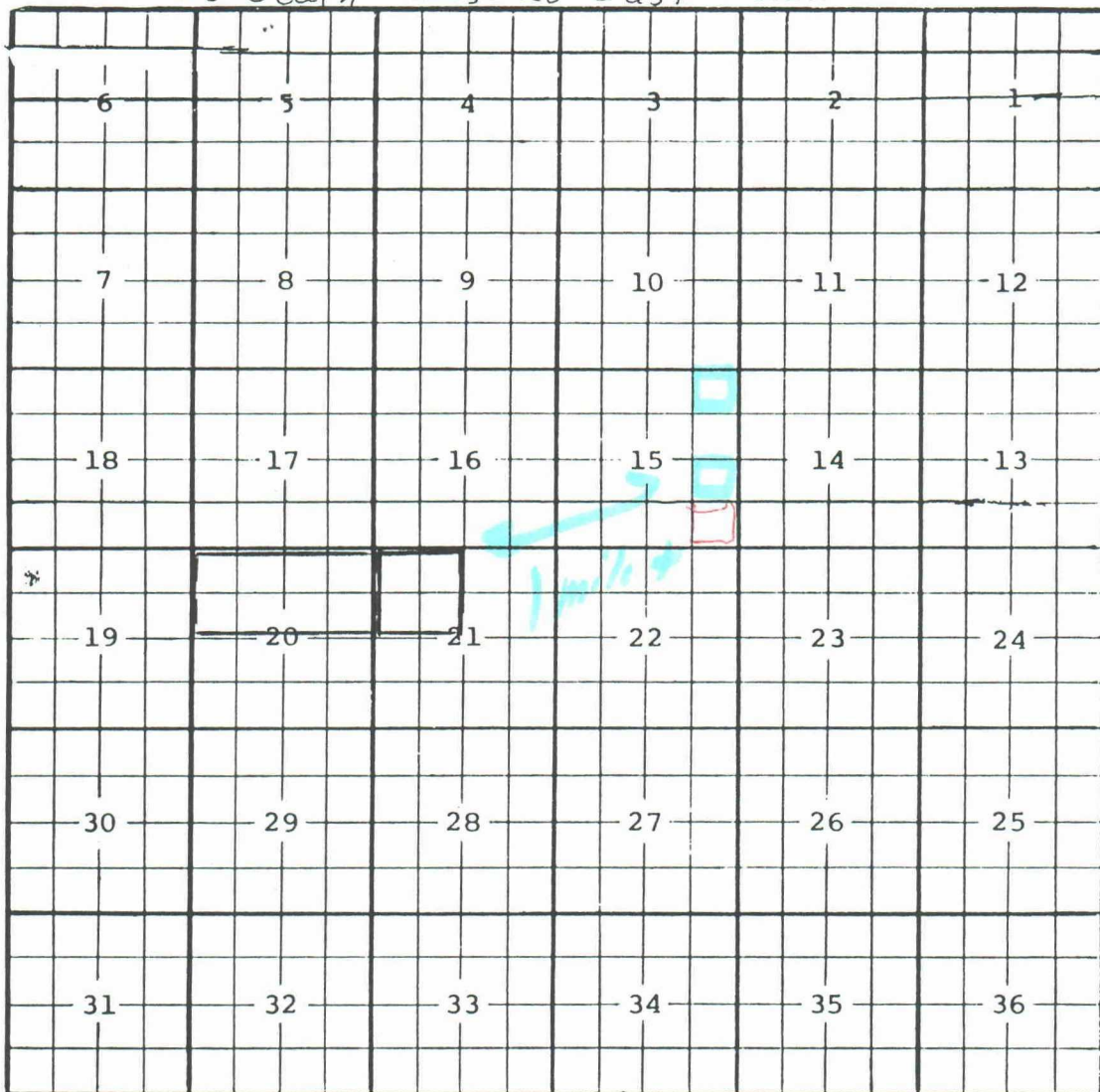
