Reference is made to your recent Order No. R-9171 for Case No. 9936 which was heard on May 2, 1990 in Santa Fe, New Mexico. please refer to my letter of April 25, 1990 concerning BHP Petroleum Company Inc.'s position in this matter (copy of letter enclosed).

Because of the recent decision in Case No. 9936 (f), (g), and (i), BHP Petroleum Company Inc. is still operating three PrePermian gas wells located in the same general area out of two different field Additionally, the fields, from the best that I can tell, still have some acreage description problems.

It would be most helpful to BHP if we could resolve the problems associated with the Comanche Spring and Rabbit Flats PrePremian gas fields. I again believe that this can be accomplished by doing the following:

- Abolish the Rabbit Flats PrePermian Gas Pool;
- Delete the W/2 Section 36, TlOS, R27E from the Comanche Spring PrePermian Gas Pool;
- Add the W/2 Section 36, TlOS, R26E to the Comanche Spring PrePermian Gas Pool (BHP operated Yates "36" State No.1 well):
- Add the N/2 Section 8, TllS, R27E to the Comanche Spring PrePermian Gas Pool (BHP operated Conoco "8" Federal Com No. 1 well);
- Add the S/2 Section 25, TlOS, R26E to the Comanche Spring PrePermian Gas Pool (Samedan operated State "35" No. 1 well); and

6. Correct the proration unit description for the BHP operated Ervin Ranch State "Com" No. 1 well to reflect All Section 5, TllS, R27E instead of the N/2 Section 5.

These corrections, deletions and additions will significantly assist BHP in reporting field production to the proper agencies. Also this will eliminate the problem of having two fields covering the same type of production in the same area.

Gentlemen:

We recently talked about the existing problem of having two fields covering parts of the same lands - Comanche Spring and Rabbit Flats. BHP Petroleum Company Inc. requested that these fields be combined into only the Comanche Spring - PrePermian Gas Pool so that both the State of New Mexico and BHP's records would not be confused.

In Docket No. 12-90, Case 9936 (f),(g) and (i) was made as an attempt to clarify the Comanche Spring - PrePermian Gas Pool by accomplishing the following:

- Abolishing the Rabbit Flats PrePermian Gas Pool (f);
- 2. Deleting the W/2 Section 36, T10S, R27E from the Comanche Spring PrePermian Gas Pool (g); and
- 3. Adding the Samedan operated State "35" Com. No. 1 wel (S/2 Section 25, T10S, R26E) to the Comanche Spring Field (i).

Each of these orders are definitely a step in the right direction. However, in order to complete the records for the Comanche Spring - PrePermian Gas Pool, BHP believes it will be necessary to include the following wells and lands in the corrected Field:
