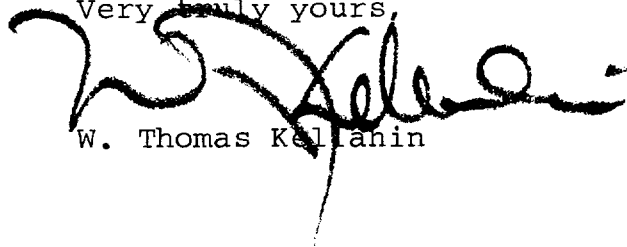

Hedges #100 (Proposed Well - not Staked)	Section 23: W/2 E/2, E/2 NE/4, NE/4 SE/4 Section 24: NW/4 NW/4 Township 31 North, Range 12 West 320.00 acres

1. Southland Royalty Company is 100% owner of the non-standard proration and spacing unit proposed for the East #13 well and has an existing Operating Agreement cover the non-standard spacing and proration unit for the Hedges #100 Well.

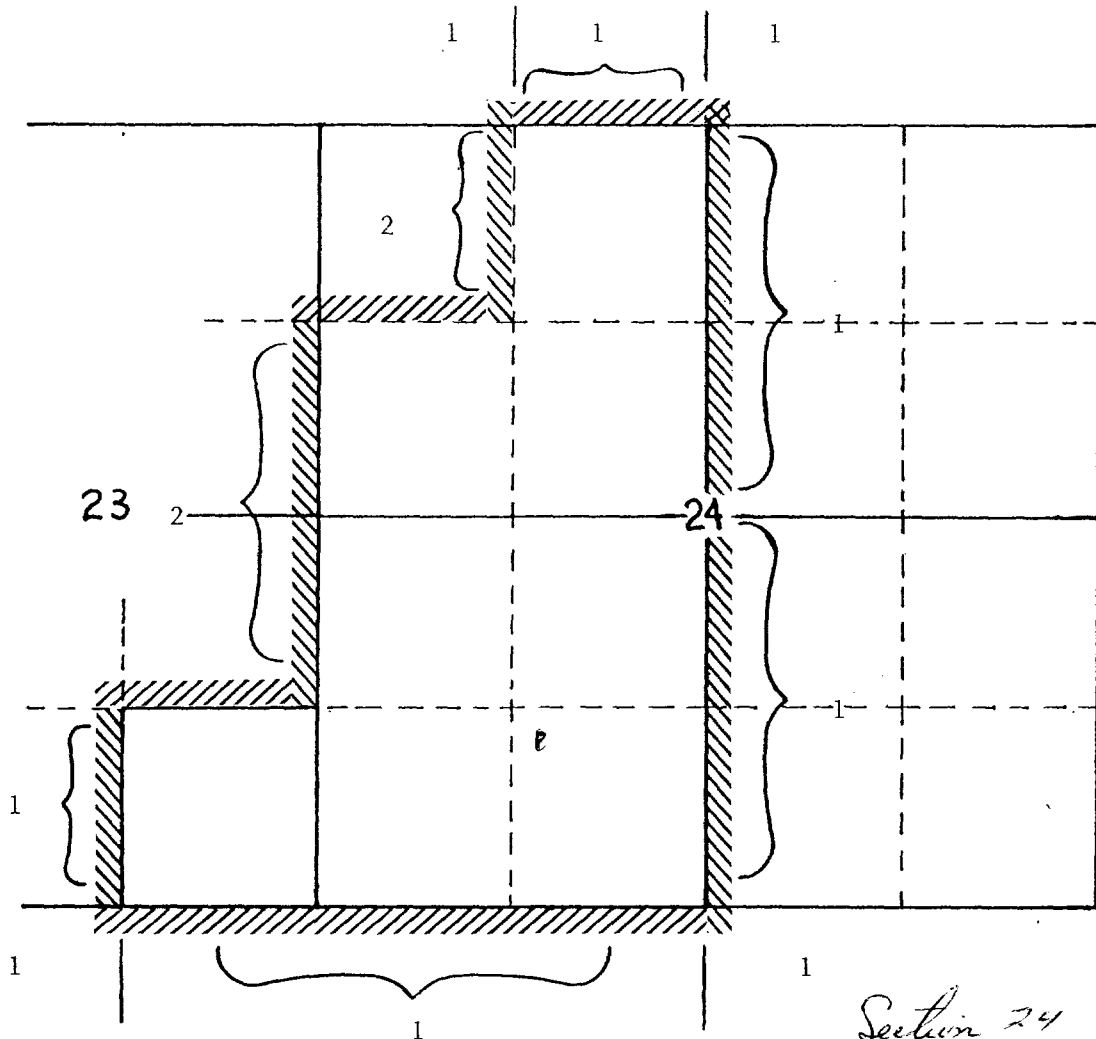

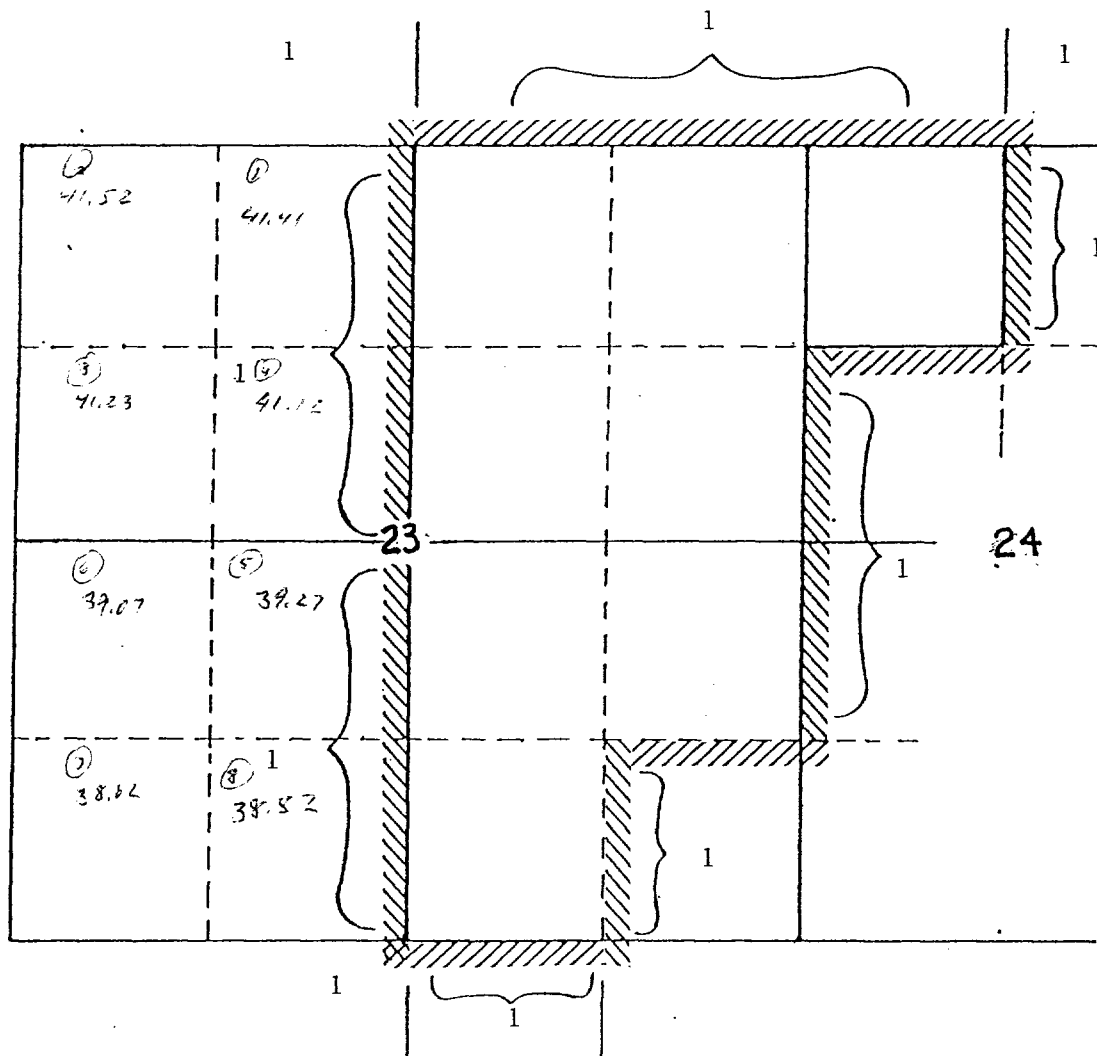

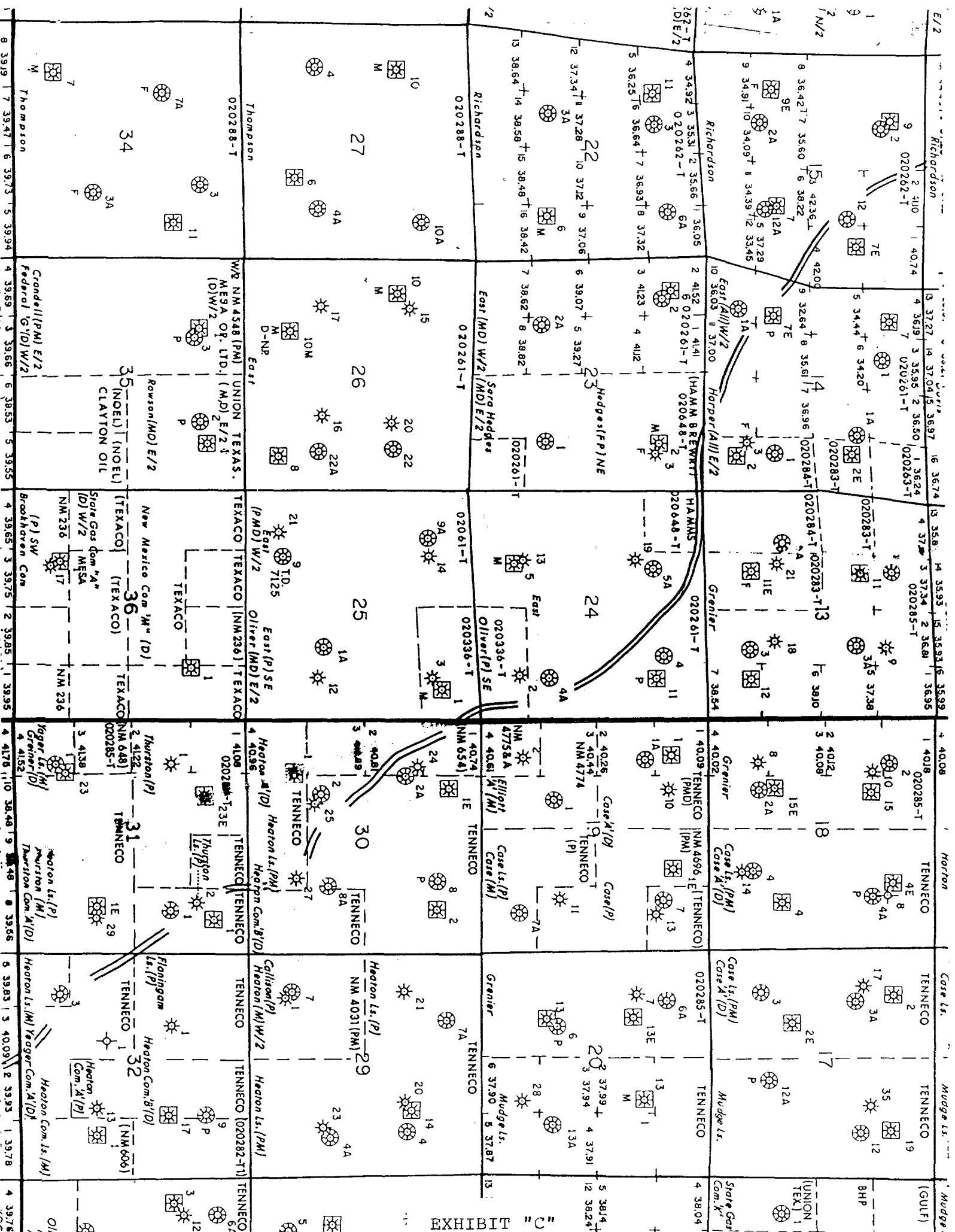
